Boca Project Management Team (PMT) phone call Update:

- No public inquiries to BOR on Boca construction
- CA water board gave approval of a variance to proceed with the April Construction
- Accountability report will be done by next PMT meeting.
  - BOR (Jie) to prepare a schedule and budget for the accountability report.
  - BOR is going to send WCWCD the Consultant review board report.
- Construction Schedule is on track.
  - Contractor thinks they will be done with the embankment mid to late July depending on weather. Lake is at 5,556
  - During May Contractor became 90% complete with Stability Berm.
  - Filter zone construction restarting 5/28
